GALT MUSEUM OFFERS FINAL BUS TOUR FOR 2008

ANCIENT HISTORY UNEARTHED AMMOLITE TOUR | FRI NOV 14, 1-4:30 PM

Local and area residents will have a chance to visit the Korite International Ammolite mine one last time in 2008 as the Galt Museum & Archives offers the **Ancient History Unearthed Ammolite Tour** on **Friday, November 14** from **1:00 to 4:30pm**.

When the City of Lethbridge designated Ammolite as its Official Gemstone on April 30, 2007, interest in Ammolite and the Korite International mining operation just south of Lethbridge has grown.

The Ammolite tour follows this summer's successful interpretive bus tours organized by the Galt to Blackfoot Crossing Historical Park and the newly renovated Frank Slide Interpretive Centre.

For this tour, participants will meet at the Galt Museum & Archives for an introduction and bus excursion to the mine site to examine the environmental and cultural impact of Ammolite mining. Following the mine tour, participants will return to the Galt for refreshments and exhibit viewing.

Due to the terrain at the mine, this tour is not wheelchair accessible. Walking and standing will be required. Participants are asked to dress appropriately for the weather. The tour can not go ahead if terrain is muddy – refunds will be offered if this is the case.
