## TWO-DAY, 3-D SCULPTURE EXHIBIT THIS WEEKEND

SAT SEP 13 | 10 – 4:30 AND SUN SEP 14 | 1 – 4:30

**Thirteen local and area artists** are represented in this weekend's inaugural **Sculpture Exhibit** at the Galt Museum & Archives **in celebration of ArtWalk** – a self-guided tour of art venues and performance events organized by the Allied Arts Council.

The three-dimensional pieces demonstrate use of a wide range of media by artists **Heather MacDonald-SoroChan** [raku clay & glazes], **Carolla Christie** [Brazilian soapstone], **Alex Pavlenko** [composite marble and resin], **Mary-Anne McTrowe** [crocheted yarn], **April Matisz** [modified thrift-store books], **Rosemary Foder** [glass and metal], **Marlene Lacey** [mixed media, co-polymer], **Jim and Eileen Jones** [wood], **Shannon Pahara** [found metal] and bronzes by **Vincent, Mirjam and Richard Luykenaar**.

**Demonstrations** are also planned for both afternoons, from **1:00 to 4:00 pm** in the Community Savings Learning Centre. **Marlene Lacey** will show the process she uses to begin a new sculpture, by creating a wooden armature, or support, as the first phase. Using a lathe, the **Chinook Wood Turning Guild** will demonstrate the transformation of a piece of exotic wood into beautiful three-dimensional art.

Visitors can also view the **Chinook Winds mural by local artist Alex Pavlenko** [Discovery Hall]; along with historic photographs from the **Galt Archives** throughout the Education Centre and the exhibit ***In Transit: Exploring Community in Motion*** on the lower level. *For you the war is over. Second World War POW Experiences* closes Sunday, September 21.

Admission rates for the Galt are **\$5** adults, **\$4** seniors/post-secondary students, **\$3** ages 7-17, **free** ages 0-6, and **\$12** family.
