Strap on ye swords, bring ye optical illusion devices... the Galt Museum & Archives presents **Eggstravaganza Meets King Arthur** on Easter weekend! The popular annual program – a great family alternative to the Easter Egg Hunt – takes place **Saturday, March 22 from 10:00 am to 2:00 pm**.

Families can participate in egg colouring, facepainting and craft activities, and between 12:00 and 1:00 children will be able to meet and learn about the ancestors of dragons. Devil's Coulee Dinosaur Heritage Museum will also be on site with information on their upcoming activities. Meanwhile, an **Easter Bunny** spokesperson has assured Museum staff that Eggstravaganza is on its list of must-hop-to events, so hugs and candies are expected – parents are reminded to bring a camera!

Admission to the event is \$4 [\$3 annual pass holders] per child and includes all materials plus entry to the Discovery Hall, home of the Medieval exhibit *Once Upon A Time... Knights, Castles & Common Folk*. All proceeds support Galt Museum education programs.
