GARDEN PLANTING AND ROAD CONSTRUCTION

This fall, grounds around the Galt Museum will be undergoing much anticipated updates:

- **Wednesday, SEPTEMBER 17** beginning at 10:00 am: **Lethbridge and District Horticultural Society** will plant plants for its Centennial Native Plant Garden at the north entrance to the Galt Museum [*photo opportunity*]. The Society will be celebrating its 100 Anniversary in 2009.
- 5th Avenue South road improvements beginning this week will mean that **5 Avenue access to the Galt is no longer useable**. Those planning to attend the Community In Blooms tradeshow this week, and all other visitors, will need to use the 4 Avenue access to the Galt Museum parking lot during road construction.
- **MID-OCTOBER:** Hilgersom Paving and Landscaping will place **250 engraved bricks** sponsored by Galt Babies, Galt School of Nursing Alumnae and others near the remaining 1891 hospital wall located to the south-east of the museum's 1910 Galt Hospital wing. This is to be followed by the placing of the Galt School of Nursing Graduate bronze sculpture created by local artist Don Toney. The sculpture is currently at a foundry in Calgary.
- Updates will be sent regarding exact timing of the brick laying and sculpture placement.
